

OVERVIEW:

The Martin Luther King, Jr. Celebration for Florida Scholarship Committee is pleased to announce the awarding of scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 to honor the life and legacy of the late Reverend Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. to Volusia County high school students in the graduating class of 2021.

Our goal is to assist the scholarship recipients with expenses while attending a postsecondary institution.

The scholarship committee will review all application information and rank applicants based on the attached criteria.

Recipients will be introduced at the annual banquet the evening of January 16, 2020. Scholarship checks will be disbursed with proof of acceptance and class registration for the fall 2020 term.

APPLICATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED BY NOVEMBER 15, 2019

Scholarship Requirements

- 1. Volusia County high school graduate
- 2. Cumulative High School GPA of 3.0 or greater
- 3. Official High School transcript (in a sealed envelope)
- 4. Completion of a 500-word essay based on the topic below. The essay must be approximately 1-2 pages and typed in a 12-point font.

If Dr. King had 20/20 vision, what relevant issues would he consider in Empowering Our Youth to Move Forward and how would he do so?

- 5. Three (3) <u>separate letters</u> of recommendations from <u>non-family members</u>, which encompass (1) Verification of your role in community activities (2) describe/list involvement in extra-curricular activities in school (3) teacher recommendation. <u>All letters must be on official letterhead</u>. <u>Please clearly delineate on each letter whether it is community, extra-curricular or teacher recommendation</u>.
- 6. Photo Release Form signed by a parent or guardian.
- 7. Acceptance and enrollment verification on university/college letterhead at an accredited institution of higher education for the fall 2020 semester. These documents should be submitted a soon as they are available.

Recipients of the Scholarship must also:

- 8. Attend the MLK Gospel Explosion on Sunday January 12, 2020 at 4:00p.m.
- 9. Attend the MLK Banquet on Thursday January 16, 2020 at 7:00p.m.
- 10. Attend the MLK Worship Service on Sunday January 19, 2020 at 4:00p.m.
- 11. Attend the Breakfast, March and Festival on Monday January 20, 2020 beginning 8:00a.m.
- 12. Participate in a day of service project. TBA
- 13. Participate in community service, volunteering a minimum of 5 hours. These hours must be served between January 27-July 10, 2020.
